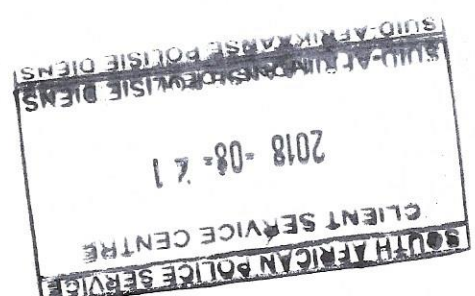

SWORN AFFIDAVIT – B-BBEE EXEMPTED MICRO ENTERPRISE COVER LETTER

Amended B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice were gazetted on 11 October 2013. The Amended Codes contain important changes from the 2007 B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.

The annual turnover threshold for qualifying as an Exempted Micro Enterprise (EME) has been increased from R5 million under the 2007 Codes to R10 million under the 2013 Codes.

Under the 2007 Codes, an EME required an auditor's certificate or similar certificate from an accredited verification agent to confirm their B-BBEE status.

Under the 2013 Codes, an EME is required to obtain a sworn affidavit confirming turnover for the past 12 months and the level of black ownership.

Under the 2013 Codes, EMEs qualify as follows:

Black Ownership	BEE Status Level	Procurement Recognition
100% Black Owned EME	Level 1	135%
≥51% Black Owned EME	Level 2	125%
<51% Black Owned EME	Level 4	100%

EMEs automatically qualify as Empowering Suppliers.

Relevant extracts from the 2013 Code

4. Eligibility as an Exempted Micro Enterprise (EME)

- 4.1 *An enterprise with an annual Total Revenue of R10 Million or less qualifies as an Exempted Micro-Enterprise.*
- 4.2 *An Exempted Micro-Enterprise is deemed to have a B-BBEE status of "Level Four Contributor" having a B-BBEE recognition level of 100% under paragraph 8.2.*
- 4.3 *Enhanced B-BBEE recognition level for an Exempted Micro-Enterprise:*
 - 4.3.1 *Despite paragraph 4.2 an EME which is 100% Black owned qualifies for elevation to "Level One Contributor" having a B-BBEE recognition level of 135%.*
 - 4.3.2 *Despite paragraph 4.2 and 4.3.1 an EME which is at least 51% Black owned qualifies for elevation to "Level Two Contributor" having a B-BBEE recognition level of 125%.*
- 4.4 *Despite paragraph 4.2 and 4.3, an EME is allowed to be measured in terms of the QSE scorecard should they wish to maximise their points and move to a higher B-BBEE recognition level.*
- 4.5 *An EME is only required to obtain a sworn affidavit on an annual basis confirming the following:*
 - 4.5.1 *Annual Total Revenue of R10 million or less; and*
 - 4.5.2 *Level of Black ownership.*
- 4.6 *Any misrepresentation in terms of Para 4.5 above constitutes a criminal offence as set out in the B-BBEE Act as amended.*
